For Theme (1):

[Matter of Discussion for the International Consortium for Universities of Education in East Asia Operation Project Team]

Under the leadership of Chancellor Kyoko Muramatsu, the 7th International Symposium for Universities of Education in East Asia is planned to be held on November 3rd (Saturday) and 4th (Sunday) ad Garden City, Shinagawa. In order to forward first event notification by mid-May, the Office of Promoting International Strategies Committee discussed the symposium's objectives and program.

For Theme (2):

While reflecting about last year's activity, we investigated the importance of this university's internationalization policy. Moreover, after furthering our knowledge about the changes in government's foreign student policy and setting a numerical target concerning this university's internationalization, detailed investigations were held.

Result

For Theme (1):

With cooperation from members of the Office of Promoting International Strategies Committee and Staff of the International Division, we completed a proposal for the first event notification.

For Theme (2):

Because of Tokyo Gakugei University's teacher-training program, it is difficult for students to study abroad for a long period of time.

The members of the committee shared the opinion that the emphasis of Tokyo Gakugei University's internationalization should be shifted from a 1 week study abroad program to a program that is about 10 days long.
