<p>For Theme (1):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The general manager of Office of Promoting International Strategies, the director of the International Student Exchange Center, the manager of the International Division and certain members of faculty discussed subsidiary bodies of the Office of Promoting International Strategies. <p>For Theme (2):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Activities for the International Consortium for Universities of Education in East Asia To promote inter-exchanging program for undergraduate students among member universities of the Consortium, applied for "EY2013 International Exchange Program with utilizing the educational facilities for juveniles" by submitting a proposal named "Exchange program for undergraduate students among member universities of the International Consortium for Universities of Education in East Asia ~Volunteer activities after the Great East Japan Earthquake and Tsunami~". This program is publicly recruited by Sports and Youth Bureau of the MEXT. Collected information on our university's volunteer activities in Naruko in 2011 for implementing the program. Examined the procedures for recruiting the host in "Mutual students exchange program in the International Consortium for Universities of Education in East Asia" adopted by JASSO's AY 2013 Student Exchange Support Program (Scholarship for Short-Term Visit/Short-Term Stay Program)

<p>For Theme (1):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Vice president Prof. Kenji Fuji assumed the post of general manager from April. With some committee members from faculty changing, the newly started office held the 1st meeting. Proposed a plan for setting 4 subcommittee groups under the new Office of Promoting International Strategies. They are Short-Term Exchange Program Committee, Life Support Committee, operative group for International Consortium for Universities of Education in East Asia and working group for Promoting International Strategies. Drew up "AY2013 Application Form for short-term exchange program" authorized by the Office of Promoting International Strategies. Authorized a short-term training program at the Hong Kong Institute of Education. Drew up a basic policy plan for international cooperative program at TGU. 	

For Theme (2):

- Reported the participants from TGU for the 8th International Symposium on Teacher Education in East Asia as the first deadline is closed.
- Prof. Manabu Kishi, the chief of Doctoral Course of the United Graduate School of Education, joined the committee in order to draw up a program of international graduate school and enhance a pilot program for doctoral course.
