<p>(1): Activities of the Office of Promoting International Strategies Together with Office of Promoting International Strategies personnel and teachers in the International Affairs Office, we considered a program that utilizes the features and individuality of Tokyo Gakugei while being based on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Mid-Term Plan/Mid-Term Targets and policy issues in the country for campus open recruitment of FY2015 budget request special expenses (project: [New Project]).</p> <p>(2): Activities of the International Consortium for Universities of Education in East Asia Project Implementation Group We dispatched ten students to Beijing/Tangshan in China from December 9 to December 14 and successfully completed activities as a dispatch project of the “FY2013 International Consortium for Universities of Education in East Asia Affiliated University Student Invitation and Exchange Project” (Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology’s Sports and Youth Bureau “International Exchange Project Utilizing Youth Education Facilities” grant challenge). After the completion of this, preparations were made toward the creation of a results report for the project.</p>	
<b>Results</b>	
<p>(1): We created a document called “Acceptance of Foreign Students and the Training of Global Human Resources to Capture the Development of the World: TGU International Student Step Up Program” for open recruitment in the “Enhancement of International and Excellent Education and Research Base Functions” among the special expenses projects. When a delegation led by Professor Hong Lin of Beijing Normal University visited our school, they met with Takeshi Fujii, Director and Vice-President, and discussions took place on the development of a program to further stimulate student exchanges in both schools. Jai-Hee Lee, President of Gyeongin National University of Education in South Korea, paid a courtesy visit to Yasuko Muramatsu, President, and an exchange agreement signing ceremony was held.</p>
